

CAMPSITE INSPECTION RULES

1. Campsite must have a permanent church flag. This flag must be 3' x 5' placed on a vertical or horizontal pole.
2. Neatness counts. Be sure to have the girls pick-up your camp area. No litter or paper. Bring tall kitchen garbage bags and dispose of daily trash in the receptacle provided for you. Please make sure your bags are tied.
3. Sleeping bags should be neatly rolled up or neatly laid out on bed or in sleeping area. Clothes and personal items should be neatly stored. Nothing should be touching sides of tent.
4. First Aid box and lanterns should be kept on table or in clear view.
5. Food must be securely packed and neatly stored. Cooking equipment must be kept clean and properly stored when not in use.
6. Empty dirty dishwater when dishes are finished. Make sure you have a place to wash your hands when preparing the meals.
7. Leave tent flaps open (unless it rains). All lines should be tight and pegs well driven into the ground. Lines should have ribbon or cloth tied on them to make them clearly visible for safety. Tent doors should all face the center of the campsite.
8. Safety procedures must be followed for all tools.
9. Have a bucket of water with ample water in it near your cook stove or fire, and next to each tent.
10. Make sure all fires extinguished when cooking is finished.
11. Make sure the tent is at least 20 feet from fire.
12. In order for your group to be eligible for the awards, you must be present for entire Powette.

SAFETY
All fires extinguished
Fire buckets in place

First Aid kit in plain sight

COOKING AREA/SANITATION
No open food
Tables cleaned
Clean dishes/cookware/utensils
Garbage properly disposed
Dirty dishwater emptied
Place to wash hands
SLEEPING AREA/TENTS
All tent screens zipped
All tent flaps open
Interior of tent uniform
Interior of tent clean
Personal gear stowed away
